

2.02 SECTION 2 - CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND RULES

PLCC will not be held liable for any injuries occurring on playground equipment, horseshoe pits, BMX track, Volleyball Court or on any other PLCC owned property. General rules and guidelines are in place, but it is the member's responsibility to supervise children and abide by "best practice". Some general guidelines to follow are:

- Always play safe by being careful and showing courtesy, no pushing, shoving or tripping, verbal abuse will not be permitted. Take your turn while using play areas;
- Wear proper clothing. Make sure your shoes are tied and never wear clothes that have drawstrings. Necklaces, scarves, drawstrings and very loose clothes could get tangled. Take off bicycle helmets before using playground equipment. Bicycle helmets can get trapped on equipment and strangle a child;
- Sit in the centre of the swing. Never stand or kneel. Hold on with both hands. Stay far away from moving swings. Stop the swing completely before getting off;
- Wait your turn on the slide. Make sure no one is in front before sliding down. After sliding down, get away from the front of the slide;
- Don't slide down the fireman's pole if someone is close to the bottom. Hold on with both hands and wrap your legs around the pole when you slide;
- Stay away from the merry-go-round until completely stopped and never jump off while it's still moving;
- Guardrails are there to protect you. Don't climb over them;
- Play only on dry equipment. If it is wet, you could slip and fall;
- If a part seems broken, loose, or in need of other maintenance, report it to the Office Manager immediately and it will be designated as "off limits" until inspected and repaired.
