Swimming Pool Rules:

Maximum Occupancy: 70

Paradise Lakes Country Club ("PLCC") operates a limited use swimming pool, as defined under WAC 246-26-010(46) (a). **No lifeguard is on duty at the PLCC pool.** All PLCC Members and their guests who use the pool do so at their own risk, and must abide by the following rules.

Children under age 16 must be supervised by a responsible adult, 18 years or older.

Children between the ages 16 and 17 cannot use pool alone.

Everyone must take a cleansing shower before using pool.

If you have a disease that can be transmitted by water or have been ill with diarrhea or vomiting in the last 2 weeks, don't use the pool.

Diapers must be changed in the designated changing area and must be swim approved.

Pets are prohibited in the pool area.

People with seizure, heart, or circulatory problems should not swim alone.

No running, diving or rough playing.

No food or drink allowed in the pool or on pool decks.

Don't use pool when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

If you don't follow the rules, you may be removed from the premises.

In an Emergency, call 911.

Emergency phone is located outside bathrooms in library.

First-Aid Kit is located in pool room by bathroom entrance.

CAMPER'S POOL RULES

There is no pool attendant on duty. Swimmers swim at their own risk. The following rules are established for safety and health reasons and to protect the pool facility. They <u>must</u> be obeyed. Violators of these rules will risk losing their family's pool privileges. Club office and maintenance personnel will periodically visit the pool and enforce all of the rules. Pool is also monitored via camera in the office. Further, adults in the pool area should be conversant with the rules and should remind any violators.

RULES

WHO IS PERMITTED TO USE THE FACILITIES

- Access to the pool and use of the facility is permitted only to Camper's Members in good standing and their guests.
- A Camper member must sign the pool register, indicating their name, division and lot number, the number of family members and guests brought to the pool area, and the

time in and time out of the pool area. Anyone who refuses to provide the requested information is not allowed to remain in the pool area.

- Children 16 years of age or under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years of age or older)
- Anyone 16 and 17 years old may not use the pool alone.

SAFETY RULES

- Inexperienced swimmers age 12 and under must be accompanied in the pool at all times by a responsible adult (18 years of age or older)
- Water wings are allowed in the shallow end only. AN ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY ALL CHILDREN WEARING WATER WINGS.
- Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back
- The following activities are *prohibited* in the pool and deck area; running, excessive splashing and horseplay, dunking, chicken fights, diving, back dives, back jumps, and running jumps into the pool. Swimmers may jump into the pool from two (2) NORMAL steps away. No throwing objects in the pool.
- The following items are prohibited in the pool area; Gum, glass objects, rafts, air mattresses, kick boards and super soaker water guns (only small hand held water guns allowed no bigger than 6 inches as long as parents supervise their use and children are not pointing them at other small children or adults). The Board will ban all water guns if there are numerous complaints. No water toys allowed in the building. Absolutely no food or beverages allowed in the pool or pool deck area. Snorkels and flippers may be worn at the PLCC staff discretion.
- Persons with open sores, wounds, rashes, bandages (not Band-Aids) or infectious diseases are not allowed in the pool.

HEALTH RULES

- Swimmers must shower before using the pool or spa.
- Young children must be toilet trained or wear approved swim diapers and must be accompanied in the pool by a parent or responsible adult.
- No person may enter the water if they have a communicable disease, open sores, or while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Anyone who observes fecal matter or vomit in the pool should immediately notify
 everyone to leave the pool. And, contact maintenance or the office. The pool will be
 closed to all swimming at least until the next day.

PROTECTION OF POOL FACILITY

- Only proper swimwear is allowed. No cutoffs are permitted.
- Tee shirts with swimwear under the tee will be allowed.
- Street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck.

• No smoking, eating or drinking is allowed in the dressing room, pool area or on the pool deck.

RULES OF BEHAVIOR

• Inappropriate or offensive language or behavior is not permitted.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES / POLICE EMERGENCIES

• <u>Call 911</u> on the emergency phone located in the entrance to the main hall. Identify the type of emergency.

(The address of the pool is 8487 Sumas - Kendall Road.)

- <u>Provide what assistance</u> you are qualified to give to the injured person.
- <u>Station an individual outside</u> by the highway to guide the Emergency Response Team.
- Send a person to find office or maintenance staff
